This 9,500 SF school and San Diego Community Teleconference Center, located at San Diego City College, has three classrooms, a conference and teleconference room, faculty development office, kitchen, control rooms, and an art gallery. A tower houses the service functions and helps to define the campus's main entry. In addition, a sculptural staircase with its axis aligned towards downtown San Diego, acts as a welcoming gesture to this point of entry. Finally, an art gallery, with an east facing glass facade, serves as a lighted beacon at night.
