Located in the City of Chula Vista, California, this 16,000 SF recreation center and ancillary shade structure buildings are designed jointly with a new 10.6 acre community park located in a new residential development. The recreation center includes a full gymnasium, multi-purpose meeting and activity rooms and is integrated as an anchor to the steeply sloping park site. The street corner is engaged by the building edges that create a pedestrian gateway into the park. Ocean views from the park are preserved over the building. RNT is a subconsultant to Van Dyke Partnership Landscape Architects on this project.
