

## Balboa Elementary School Modernization and Classroom Addition

This 52,000 SF elementary school modernization, masterplan and addition is composed of new classrooms, central courtyard and lunch shelter, and the renovation of existing classrooms and administration buildings. The courtyard organizes the campus while strengthening the school's relationship to its surrounding community. On the outside edge of the new circular courtyard, a "circle of friends" theme is introduced and expressed by incorporating student handprints, footprints and names in the concrete.
