

Isla Vista Elementary School

Located in Goleta, California, this 51,000 SF state-of-the-art elementary school replaces the existing facilities which were originally built in the late 1950s. A series of staff workshops were initiated to develop the school's unique teaching program and help strengthen and enhance the community's identity. The project includes 31 new classrooms, a multipurpose building, library, administration offices and additional support facilities. This project won the 2001 AIACC Savings by Design Energy Efficiency Integration Award.
