

Jefferson Elementary School Modernization and Addition

As part of the Proposition MM School Facilities Improvement Program for the San Diego Unified School District, Roesling Nakamura Terada Architects, Inc. (RNT) was chosen to assist in providing design and construction administration services for modernization and new construction services for Jefferson Elementary School. The project included a new 3,000 SF library which included a 500 SF outdoor literacy garden, remodel of the existing Administration Building, accessibility upgrades and technology and finish upgrades of the existing classroom buildings. The design process included comprehensive field investigations and utilized design workshops with local community members, and school and district staff members.
