Torrey Pines High School West Campus was scheduled in phases, starting with site improvements. The project responds to the school's growing student population needs to the year 2010. Its state-of-the-art facilities include a permanent 37,000 SF 24-classroom wing addition, 20 environmentally-responsive relocatable classrooms, campus entry enhancements and a new 7,000 SF student counseling center. This project received an Award of Excellence from CASH/AIACC and an AIA Honor Award.
